The project commenced with the demolition of the existing community hall located on a compact site in Mill Hill where the neighbours were residential houses and a working Synagogue. Construction of the new steel framed community hall on piled foundations followed. External elevations of stone cladding masonry and glazing with a main roof feature erected over.

External works incorporated amendments to the access areas of the existing synagogue to ease arrangements required by less able bodied persons.
