

KING SOLOMON HIGH SCHOOL, ILFORD

The design and construction of a new extension to King Solomon High School, including alterations to 4 existing classrooms, corridors and reception area including the construction of a 698m² Arts & Music space on 2 storeys.

This project will also include further internal alterations to the existing Fairlop building to accommodate the 6th Form and Administration activities, together with the associated changes to services and drainage and renewing hard and soft landscaping.



The original building was constructed by HG Construction Ltd approximately 10 years ago, so it was a very welcome return to the site and a pleasure to work with the School again.

Although the works commenced and will be completed in term time with students in close proximity, we timed the heavy frame and envelope construction to accord with the summer holiday to mitigate the risks potentially to students, the teachers and the public.
