

LABORATORY EXTENSION/REFURBISHMENT

UNIVERSITY COLLEGE LONDON

The work at this busy London University involved the internal conversion and refurbishment of the upper and lower basements and first floor office areas. The existing building, altered whilst the remainder was in occupation, is a concrete clad steel frame with concrete floors (part of which had to be replaced). The refurbishment included a combination of laboratories and office fitting out and all mechanical and electrical services. The works were in two phases to allow the University to continue working in its day to day role.
